- Date and place of birth
- What did he/she do throughout his/her life (at least 3 details)
- How did he/she dedicate his or her life to the Catholic church
- How did he/she die
- What miracles are attributed to this saint (2)
- What does this saint mean to you personally (at least a paragraph to explain)
- When is this Saint's feast day and what is he/she the Patron Saint of?
